Unpaid Work Experience Placements are an activity that may be used to support people who are unable to obtain paid employment and needing work experience such as persons who are new entrants to the Canadian Labour Market, persons with disabilities, persons with no or little work experience or without recent work experience, specialized populations, or long term unemployed persons.
